Jorge joined Eurofighter as Chief Executive Officer in January 2025. He leads the Company - which oversees the Eurofighter programme on behalf of industry - as a member of the Board of Management (BoM).

Jorge has more than two decades of aerospace industry experience, having started his career at Airbus (then EADS), before progressing to hold several international executive roles at Airbus Defence & Space.

Prior to joining Eurofighter, Jorge led the Airbus C295 India Programme. In India, he oversaw the largest C295 order in history, while establishing India's first private-sector aerospace and defence end-to-end production system.

Jorge has extensive Eurofighter experience having been the Programme Head for Spain, leading all activities related to the Airbus contribution within the Eurofighter consortium.

In other career roles, Jorge was responsible for the Canadian FWSAR (fixed-wing search and rescue) Programme, delivering 16 upgraded C295 aircraft alongside an advanced support infrastructure.

He also managed the United Arab Emirates' A330 MRTT Programme, guiding it from contract negotiations to fleet operations. He later led the modernisation of the MRTT platform, securing landmark contracts with Singapore.

A dual national of Spain and Germany, Jorge holds an MSc in Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering.
